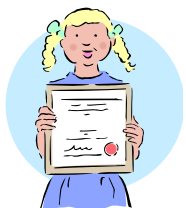

ARTS AND ACADEMICS ACADEMY!

The academy will begin the week of January 12th and last until May 13th. There will be two sessions, which will each last 8 weeks and will take place after school. The cost will be \$80 per session and includes snack and materials. Space is limited, so please sign up fast!



CLASS DESCRIPTION

Artful Instruments (Ms. Brown) Do you love Art and Music? Then this class is for you! We will be creating and decorating our own musical instruments-as many as we can in the 8 week course! Choices will include a guitar-like stringed instrument, a clay whistle, and paper-mache maracas. Opportunity to experiment with different found objects, to create other instruments including rattles, rain-sticks and drums, will also be possible. Come be creative and make some noise!

Cake Decorating (Mrs. LaCure) Students will learn basic cake decorating skills such as frosting a cake, borders, handwriting, and novelty cakes.

Creative Writing (Mr. Conway) Students will work on improving writing skills in regard to fiction, poetry, or creative nonfiction, by both critiquing published examples of strong writing and work shopping their own stories.

Digital Story Telling (Mrs. Neuman) We will work as a team to pick or write a short story, fairy tale or nursery rhyme, pick parts - both in front of the camera and behind the camera, act it out and film it; and then use Microsoft's Movie Maker to edit it into a 5 minute (or less) movie.

Exploring Desktop Computing (Mr. Green) Students will explore basic computer hardware by working in teams to disassemble, reassemble, test, and troubleshoot a desktop computer. Students will explore basic systems administration by picking an operating system and installing it on their team's computer and configuring it to connect to the local area network (LAN). Students will locate, download, and install free software for their team's computer while working through any problems that may arise.

Fitness, Fun, and Games (Ms. Brooks): Students will have the opportunity to have fun while learning about fitness! Students will learn different ways to exercise either within a group or individually. They will learn about team sports like soccer and about individual exercises like aerobics! This program gives students the chance to have fun in a fitness setting while working cooperatively with their peers.

Fowler Green Thumb (Mrs. Ablard) As Spring arrives, we will spend some time sprucing up the courtyard. We will spend time sprucing up the courtyard by planting flowers, making garden ornaments, stepping stones, bird feeders and bird houses. We will plan for some indoor garden activities in case old man winter shows up again!

Get Fit Fast with Mr. Cotter (Mr. Cotter) Students will learn how to use cardiovascular and weight training equipment properly, establish their own challenging cross-training workouts and keep a journal tracking their progress and diet. Have fun and get in shape!

Jewelry Making (Mrs. Mendonca) Explore your creativity by learning to design and create your own beautiful jewelry.

Mural Painting (Ms. Brown, Mr. Perham) Have you ever wanted your art work to be a permanent display in the school? If you would like to leave your mark on Fowler this is the class for you. In this class we will be exploring the process of mural making. We will be designing, drafting and painting a mural that could become a permanent fixture in the school.

Performing Arts (Ms. Jones) This class will integrate drama, music, and public speaking skills through the use of games and multi-cultural materials. There will be a presentation of student work at the end of the session

Photography (Ms. Lingener) Students will learn basic aspects of photography including, framing colors, camera angles, and elements of composition. Completed projects will include landscapes, buildings, portraits, macro photography and action shots. Students will need a digital camera for this course.

Picturing Writing (Mr. Thomas) Come make some books! We'll start out by using a variety of painting techniques to create lots of different papers. The papers will be torn and cut to make collage pictures. We will then create stories based on the collages.

Scrabble (Mr. Thomas) Scrabble is a great game that incorporates spelling, vocabulary, and math. The students will work individually and on teams to play and compete against each other. We will end the session with a scrabble tournament.

Scrapbook Making (Ms. Lingener) Express your own personal style! Use photos, stamps, stickers, words, or anything you choose to put together your own Scrapbook. Scrapbooks can be for personal use or they can be given as gifts.

Ultimate 4 Sport (Mr. LeSage) A combination of four sports over the span of the 16 class sessions. Flag Football, Indoor Soccer, Basketball, and Olympic Handball. Each sport will consist of four classes each having introduction drill work, small sided games, and tournament style games.
